The Indonesian nuclear power plant development program has been promoting nuclear technology and conducting activities to increase public acceptance. However, there is a phenomenon where women's support for the program is lower than men's, despite overall high public acceptance (above 70% in 2014-2016). One possible solution is to showcase female nuclear scientists, business figures, and social and political leaders who support nuclear energy to explain its benefits, especially to Indonesian women. It is also suggested that gaining support from mothers, who can influence their families, may be crucial for the success of Indonesia's nuclear energy program.
